PREPARING FOR EASTER

During this holy season of Lent we are on a journey that will bring us closer to Jesus. We prepare to celebrate the mystery of God's great love for us. His is a love so great that "...He gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish, but might have eternal life." (John...3:16).

Through the Lenten disciplines of prayer, fasting and almsgiving we have the means to grow closer to our God. The children have collected food and are making donations to fill the rice bowls in their classrooms. They have been learning about and praying the Stations of the Cross. Parents are invited to our final two celebrations of the Stations of the Cross, April 7 (2:15 pm) and April 12 (10:45 pm). Our 8th graders will be enacting the "Living Stations" on April 12. On April 4 at 1:30 the students in grades 2-8 will participate in a Lenten Reconciliation service. The focus of this prayer is an examination of conscience and a celebration of God's mercy and forgiveness. Catholic children will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As always, parents are invited to join us.

ENROLLMENT UPDATE

To date 22% of our current student body is enrolled for next year. All families are strongly urged to re-enroll before the April 15 deadline for the discounted family re-enrollment fee. On April 16 the fee jumps to \$350. Timely enrollment will enable the administration to make informed decisions about staffing, resources and the budget. Parents will benefit by having tuition contracts and other important school information well before the start of the school year.

FINANCIAL AID

There are two remaining financial aid opportunities available to our families. **No one will be considered for tuition assistance who has not completed the Financial Aid Application in TADS.** Please call Mrs. Blackburn if you need assistance with this application. Students who are parishioners of St. Matthias Church who have applied for Financial Aid through TADS are eligible to apply for a Father Hughes scholarship for next year.

KNOWLEDGE OF FAITH TESTING

All of our students in grades 2-8 will be taking a standardized religion test. This assessment measures each student's knowledge of church teaching in each of 6 domains: Scripture, Sacraments, Morality, Prayer, Christian Community and Evangelization. The test takes a little less than one class period and all grades with the exception of 2 and 7 will take it during their normal computer class period. There will be a make-up time for students who are absent.
